



Policy: Doctor of Pharmacy Degree Graduation Requirements

Each student is individually responsible for reviewing and complying with the School of Pharmacy Program requirements as well as the University of Pittsburgh academic regulations for graduation by the required deadlines.

Students must meet the following requirements to graduate with the Doctor of Pharmacy professional degree from the University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy

1. Successfully complete all required academic course requirements, earning 134.5 credits by graduation
2. Successfully earn and maintain a cumulative GPA of ≥ 2.0
3. Successfully complete introductory and advanced professional practice experiences at the minimum level of "Satisfactory Performance"
4. Successfully complete all professional and career development activities, including P-4 professional development review, and documentation
5. Demonstrate they are in good academic standing
6. Receive a vote in support as recommended by the faculty of the School of Pharmacy
7. Register for graduation and, to receive transcripts and other documents, resolve all financial obligations owed to the University
