



Pitt Pharmacy MS Scholarship

Pitt Pharmacy is offering \$20,000 scholarships towards the cost of tuition to two highly qualified and motivated students seeking a thesis MS degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences for fall 2025 enrollment.

To be considered for the Pitt Pharmacy MS Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a US citizen, non-citizen national, or permanent resident of the United States
- Submit a completed application to the University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy MS program in Pharmaceutical Sciences via PharmGrad – [How to Apply](#)
- Have a record of distinguished academic achievement (e.g., grade point average, honors, or other designation)

AND meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Come from an educational, cultural, or geographic setting that is underrepresented in graduate studies within the health sciences in the United States or specifically at the University of Pittsburgh.
- Have a disability that limits one or more life activities as described by the [American with Disabilities Act](#)
- Come from a disadvantaged background, defined as those who meet 2 or more of the following criteria: 1) Were eligible for Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program, 2) parents or legal guardians did not complete a bachelor's degree, 3) were or are currently eligible for [Pell grants](#), 4) received support from Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for women, infants, and children (WIC), 5) were in the foster care system

All applicants who meet these criteria will be given individualized consideration during the review process based on consideration of the application as a whole, and no one factor will be determinative.
